Three teens arrested for shooting out window in AP home

AVON PARK -- Two teenagers have been arrested and another has an arrest warrant in connection with shooting out a window in a home on North Beth Road in Avon Park April 8.

Peyton Alanyna Wiggins, 17, and a 14-year-old boy were charged with firing a deadly missile into a dwelling and criminal mischief. An arrest warrant on the same charges has been issued for Dylan Cordell Finigan, also 17. Finigan is also wanted for violation of probation.

The bedroom window was shot out around 11:20 p.m on April 8, when two girls were asleep in the room. The noise woke them up, and one of them told investigators she heard somebody outside said "Dylan, that's enough." Damage to the window was estimated at \$400.

Investigation revealed the three as suspects. Finigan has been prosecuted for a crime against one of the girls who lives in the home, and security footage and register receipts at the Avon Park Walmart showed that the three were together when a box of pellets like the ones found inside the bedroom were purchased. Wiggins and the 14-year-old both confessed to the crime, saying they and Finigan all rode together on an ATV from Finigan's residence to the home where the windows were shot, but they gave conflicting statements about who actually fired the gun.

This incident is not related to any of the other cases of windows being shot out around the county, detectives say. Anyone with information on Finigan's location is asked to call the HCSO at 863-402-7200.

Note: All arrests do not lead to convictions. Everyone is presumed innocent until proven guilty in court.
